Put thieves on the wrong foot - tips to keep your garden secure this Summer

- Keep an up-to-date inventory of the items in your garden and shed and record the value. Photograph valuable garden plants and ornaments and mark equipment with your postcode.
- An excellent way to keep thieves at bay is to have a barrier of thorny hedge around your garden - nature's own defence system. Noisy, crunchy gravel on paths and driveways can also deter a thief and warn you that someone is out and about on your property.
- Don't make it easy for them! Whilst it sounds obvious, be sure to lock away all tools and equipment rather than leaving them on display. Don't leave ornaments or furniture that can be removed easily outside all year unless they are secured in position.
